  - \* Hebrews 11:6 says that without faith it is impossible to please God. Read John 20:24-29 How does this tie into Corey's suggestion?
  - \* What are some times when you've exercised some bold faith?
  - \* What are some times in your life when your faith has been encouraged by a circumstance or situation?
  - \* What are some circumstances or situations when your faith was seriously challenged? How did you respond?
- What do you think could convince you to change your current stance on God's existence be that belief or unbelief?
