SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

NOAH

START LEARNING - These questions will highlight scripture and information you need to know to get the group on the same line of thought.

1. Read Hebrews 11:7. According to the passage why did God instruct Noah to build an ark?
2. Read Genesis 6:9-14. What did Noah do with God?

START THINKING AND DISCUSSING - These questions will help your group start thinking deeper and discussing.

1. God warned Noah of events to come. Why does God warn us to do and not to do things? What are some of God's biggest warnings in the scriptures and why do you think he warned us against these things? Can you think of any warnings Pastor Stan mentioned in his message?
2. How did Pastor Stan say we could live righteous in an ungodly culture? What does it look like to walk with God? According to the message what are some essential practices to walking with God?
3. Pastor Stan mention an acrostic called ACTS. What does each letter stand for and how do you apply it to your prayer time? (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication)

START CONNECTING - These questions will help your group connect personally.

1. What's a personal practice that's an anchor for your walk with God-a practice where you really feel connected when doing it but disconnected when you miss it?
2. Is there an accomplishment in your life that took significant effort and diligence? What was the key to your success? Can you apply these principles to a consistent devotional life with Jesus and how?
3. Is there a time the Lord called you to something that didn't make sense but you responded in obedience?
4. Is there a time when your committment to the Lord has been tested?
